<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Objectives and brief description. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Contribute to food and nutrition security; - Contribute to environmental preservation; - Improve the animal slaughtering conditions in Conakry city and its surroundings; - Ensure the safety of meat delivered to the consumer; - Reduce pollution of the environment through better management of effluents from slaughterhouses. ● Presentation of the project components <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Increase of the capabilities of the Kagbelen slaughterhouse by 500 head of cattle a day; - Establishment of a slaughter chain of 500 heads of small ruminants per day with suitable equipment for small ruminants; - Construction of two livestock transit parks planned on areas of 5 ha each in two main livestock access points to Conakry (Kouriah in Coyah and Khorira in Dubréka); - Construction of 9 additional blocks for butchers to strengthen existing ones. Like the old ones, they will be spread over the first 5 municipalities of Conakry and Dubréka; - Fencing a 4 ha area. ● Expected results of the project, effects/impacts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The slaughtering and meat marketing facilities that meet the health and environmental standards are available and operational; - The safety of meat delivered to consumers has improved; - Additional jobs are created.
